worked hard to improve biodiversity in Wicket Wood

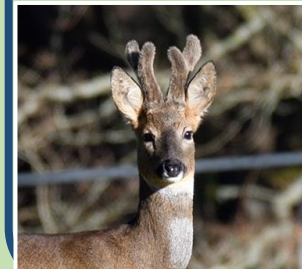
